NAMING GIFT

To establish appropriate recognition for philanthropic support of our educational community, the Rochester Community Schools Board of Education will provide opportunities for parents, staff and community members to donate funds to the Rochester Community Schools Foundation for the purpose of naming areas of schools, offices, and District owned facilities. Examples for which donations may be made for recognition purposes may include classrooms, media centers, athletic fields, natatoriums, gymnasiums, auditoriums and other parts of schools and District owned facilities. Gifts may include monetary donations, publicly traded securities, closely held securities, real estate, tangible personal property, insurance, life income plans, charitable lead trusts and bequests.

Individuals and/or organizations may donate an amount, specified within guidelines established by the Superintendent/designee for the right to name a specific area of a District owned property. The Rochester Community Schools Foundation will provide processing and recognition of the naming opportunity with final approval by the Board of Education.
